June 1st Sign Up Deadline

Chambersburg, PA for a
fine dinner & the overnight.

On the second day visit
scenic & historic sites, plus
the Swigart Automobile
Museum.

If you are participating in the Chesapeake Region Spring Overnight Tour on both Saturday & Sunday, June 6th & 7th, you must register separately for the Orphan Car Tour (see second form below) and pay the \$8 tour fee. The Saturday dinner charge of \$17 per person must be paid in advance. A separate dining room at the Family Traditions Lighthouse Restaurant in Chambersburg has been reserved for antique car folks, so you can't just walk in and get the special price and seating. There is a June 1st deadline to register. You must start the Saturday portion of the tour in Thurmont to receive the driving directions package and get your dinner tickets.

If you are continuing on the Sunday portion of the Spring Overnight Tour, you must also register (see first form below). The Overnight motel in Chambersburg, the ice cream social; plus the Swigart Museum entrance fee, lunch and dinner Sunday are on a pay-as-you-go basis. However, we must advise the motel and museum about expected attendance, so the June 1st registration deadline applies.

Orphan Car Tour June 6th

Starts at the Cozy Restaurant on Frederick St, in Thurmont, MD at 11 AM on Saturday, June 6th. Route is over scenic back roads through the Catoctin Mtns. to Chambersburg, PA, with several optional stops. At 5 PM there is a buffet dinner at the Family Traditions Lighthouse Restaurant. You can just do the tour without the dinner. The deadline for dinner reservations is June 1st.

Spring Overnight Tour June 7th

Starts at the Days Inn of Chambersburg, PA about 9 AM after breakfast for those staying at the Days Inn. Travel over back roads to Swigart's Museum in Huntingdon, PA. There will be a lunch stop after Swigart's and optional stops on the return route back to the Cozy Restaurant in Thurmont, MD – where we will have an optional group dinner before getting on the road home.

Chesapeake Region Overnight Tour Registration

The Days Inn of Chambersburg motel in Chambersburg, PA has a block of rooms reserved for June 6th. You must contact the motel and make your reservation directly with them. This year we'll team up with the Chesapeake Region of the AACA to offer a two-day touring extravaganza on June 6 & 7!

The "Orphan" portion runs Saturday, June 6, departing from the Cozy Restaurant in Thurmont, Md. As usual, each driver will be given printed directions and will travel the Tour route of about 50 miles of scenic back roads at his / her own speed, with at least five brief pauses at points of interest along the way. (Members of the Chesapeake Region will join us Saturday — "day one" of their Spring Overnight Tour.) We reach Chambersburg in late afternoon, and will enjoy a huge buffet meal at the Family Traditions Lighthouse Restaurant there. To join us for dinner in our reserved room, you must register with us and pre-pay your meal, by June 1.

There'll be plenty of time after dinner to drive home before dark, but if you're game, stay overnight and join the Chesapeake Region on Sunday morning for the second day of its Spring Overnight Tour! This continues about 60 miles north (with interesting stops along the way) to the Wm. E. Swigart, Jr. Automobile Museum in Huntingdon — America's oldest antique car museum.

12:00 PM	Cars are released onto tour route one by one (over a period of at least 30 minutes)
5:00 PM	Dinner at Family Traditions Lighthouse Restaurant, 4301 Philadelphia Ave., Chambersburg, PA

Important: **Bring a navigator** to read driving directions! Please "gas up" before you start the tour. Tour will be held **RAIN** or **SHINE**. Dinner reservations must be submitted by **June 1**. The entry fee of \$8 per car can be prepaid, or paid at the Tour.

DINNER NOTES

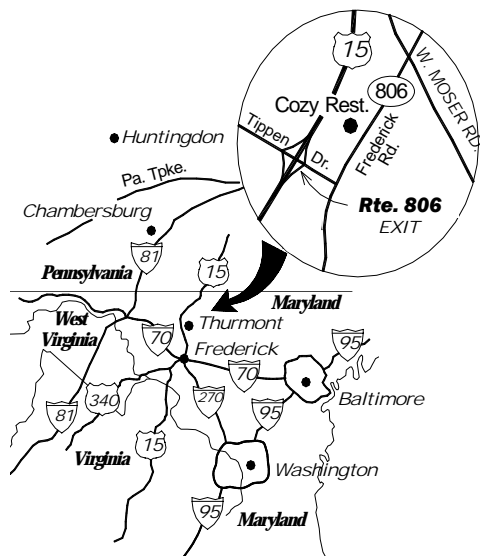
Buffet dinner varies daily but typical choices include: roast turkey, sliced roast beef, sliced baked ham, broasted chicken, 1 seafood, 1 pasta, 4 hot vegetables, 2 potatoes, corn fritters, baked beans, salad bar, dessert bar, Pepsi, iced tea or coffee...and lots more!

Dinner is limited to 70, so make reservations early (**deadline: June 1**). Your meal ticket will be held for you at the Tour. We can refund your money only until meal time. If you don't reserve, you can eat in the main restaurant, but can't eat in the reserved room or partake in the door prize drawings.

 *The Tour is open to "orphan" antique cars -- vehicles at least 25 years old which were produced either by now-defunct manufacturers or the discontinued divisions of still-existing companies.*
