Host Hotel: Quality Inn & Suites, 100 Westbank Expressways, Bldg. #A, Gretna, LA 70053. Room rates are only \$69.00, plus tax, for single king or 2 double beds. A suite rate is \$100 plus tax. NOTE: When making your room reservations, please advise them at what time you plan on arriving, as Special Arrangements have been made for early check-in being available from 10:00AM to 11:30AM for most of the rooms. A complimentary breakfast will be available for all registered guests. **Directions:** I-10 towards New Orleans, keeping right to take I-10 E towards New Orleans Business District, keep left to take US-90 Business via Exit 234A towards Gretna/Super Dome. Cross the Mississippi River Bridge towards Greta/Westwego, taking EXIT 8, Stumpf Blvd. After exiting, stay in the left lane, taking the first "U" turn after passing Evergreen Drive, which is just past Stumpf Blvd,—the motel is located on the right just after the "U" turn.

Registration: Tour Packets will available on the 1st Floor Grand Ballroom, from 10:00AM to 12:00 Noon. A free light lunch will be served, with drinks available from the drink wagon, from an all original 1937 Chevrolet Stake Body, parked outside. Friday Early Bird Tour: Depart at 1:30PM for an arranged presentation at the **New Orleans Motorsport Park**. The Park is a state of the art, full service racing and special events facility. They offer programs to the general public which includes high performance driving schools, track days, go-kart rentals, driver education courses, spectator events, and ridealongs with professional drivers and much more. This is the south's premier race track, that you will surely enjoy visiting.

Saturday Tour: Depart at 9:30AM to visit the **Gretna Historical Society's Museum Complex**. The Museum Complex has three Creole cottages, an active Blacksmith shop, and the Louisiana State Fire Museum. The Louisiana State Fire Museum is housed in the David Crockett Fire Company No. 1, 1859 firehouse, proudly displaying its "pride and joy," an 1876 steam fire pumper. Most importantly, it is the oldest, continuously active volunteer fire company in the United States. After lunch, you will visit the **Lafitte Barataria Museum in Jean Lafitte, LA**. This museum was built in the town's multipurpose complex, to preserve the heritage of those who carved a living from the thin spit of land, between the cypress swamps and the open waters of the Gulf of Mexico. There is a 30-minute film about Louisiana wetlands preservation. Then you are off to the **Jean Lafitte Welcome Center**, for a special presentation about the Pirate Jean Lafitte, and his support of the Battle of New Orleans.
